

## JOHNSTONE'S PAINT TROPHY FINAL – SUNDAY 3<sup>RD</sup> APRIL 2016

### Travel Information

- 1.1.1 The Johnstone's Paint Trophy Final will be held at Wembley National Stadium (WNSL) on Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2016. General Admission gates will open at 12:00. The match will kick-off at 14:30. The match finish time will be subject to extra time and penalties. Potential finish times are shown in Table 1.

- 1.1.2 This note presents the possible travel arrangements for Oxford United FC and Barnsley FC supporters, including journey times planned disruptions to service.

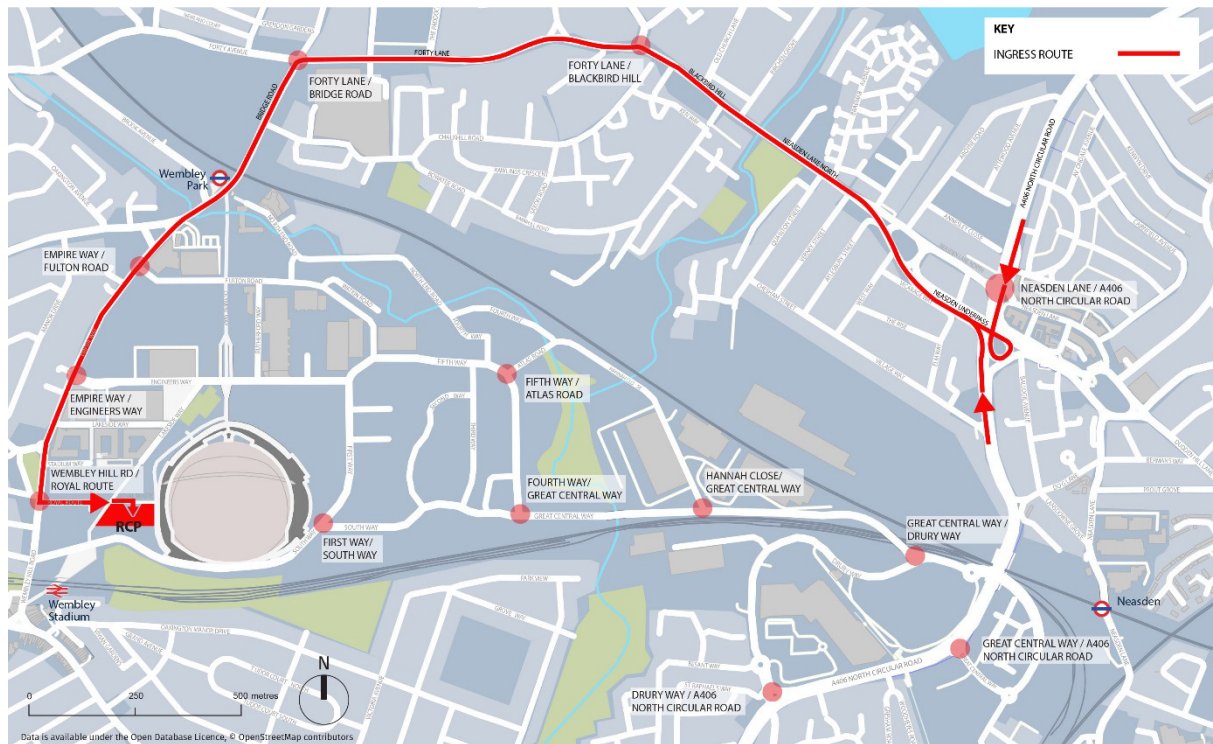
### 1.2 Road Travel

- 1.2.1 Oxford United FC coaches have been allocated to the Green Car Park (GCP) on the east side of the stadium. Oxford United FC coaches should look to arrive at the stadium via the A406 North Circular Road northbound, Drury Way and then Great Central Way to GCP.
- 1.2.2 Barnsley FC coaches have been allocated to the Retail Car Park on the east side of the stadium. Barnsley FC coaches should look to arrive at the stadium via the A406 North Circular Road southbound, Great Central Way and then First Way to RET. Please note that after the Event, highways on the east side of the stadium may be congested. We may direct coaches westbound from RET, so they can access the A406 North Circular Road northbound via Neasden Lane.

### 1.3 Travel by Train

#### Oxford United FC

- 1.3.1 Oxford United FC supporters are likely to travel to Wembley Stadium Station (a 5 minute walk from Wembley Stadium) or to Paddington Rail Station. **Please note the Bakerloo Line service will not be stopping at Paddington Rail Station.** Please plan your journey within London using <https://tfl.gov.uk/plan-a-journey/>

#### Barnsley FC

- 1.3.2 Barnsley FC supporters are likely to travel to London Kings Cross / London St. Pancras International Rail Stations, where they will have access to the Metropolitan Line which serves Wembley Park Station.

### 1.4 London Transport Travel

- 1.4.1 Please note London Buses do not accept cash payment. Payment options include an Oyster Card, purchase of a Visitor Oyster Card, Contactless Payment Card, a Day Travel Card or a One Day Bus & Tram Card. Please visit [www.tfl.gov.uk](http://www.tfl.gov.uk) to find out where you can purchase these, should you require them.

### 1.5 Wembley National Stadium Travel Recommendations

- 1.5.1 The match is due to finish between 16:15 to 17:15. This leaves adequate time for both sets of supporters to catch a return train from London to their respective stations. Please plan your travel before the Event.
- 1.5.2 Please book your coach parking spaces well in advance of the event to guarantee your parking space in one of the official car parks adjacent to the stadium.
- 1.5.3 WNSL are happy to work with all clubs to help promote coach travel.
