We believe that all children, young people, and adults at risk, regardless of age, disability, gender, racial heritage, religious belief, sexual orientation, or identity, are entitled to equal protection from harm and abuse. To uphold this commitment, we work in partnership with participants, their parents and carers, and relevant agencies to promote welfare and create a safe, supportive environment for all.

Safeguarding Practice: We have established robust safeguarding policies and procedures, which are always available for inspection and review at our office or by contacting a member of our safeguarding team. These policies are regularly reviewed and updated to ensure they reflect best practice and current legislation. All staff and volunteers are DBS checked, fully inducted, and receive regular safeguarding training and refreshers. This ensures that every child, young person, and adult at risk who engages with our services is protected and supported in a safe environment.

Input to Best Safeguarding Practice: We are committed to continuously improving our safeguarding approach and believe this is best achieved through collaboration. We work in partnership with children, young people, adults at risk, and their parents and carers to shape and strengthen our safeguarding practices. Your feedback matters. 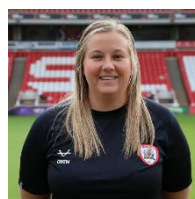

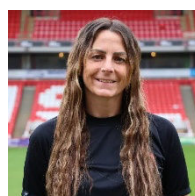

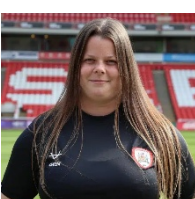
